





1. What is the time commitment like?

New Members are required to attend a one-hour training per week in addition to Weekly General Body Meetings (GBMs).

New Members, in their first semester, are expected to complete 10 credits in addition to the weekly training and meeting. These 10 credits include 2 hours of service for STAT and campus tours. Seasoned Members are required to complete 20 credits per semester, which translates to 20 hours of work, in addition to weekly general body meetings (GBMs).

2. What's required for the application?

The application will consist of a written portion which includes a resume component as well as a creative writing assignment. All applicants will schedule their group interview following the submission of their written applications. Following group interviews, a select number of applicants will be invited to participate in individual interviews.

Applicants must have a current [Students Today, Alumni Tomorrow](#) membership which has an associated fee. If you are not selected your membership will not be refunded. The organization will work with applicants with limited financial resources.

3. When will applications become available?

Applications will become available January 3, 2025.
